Columbus Landmarks is pleased to award the Ed Lentz Prize in honor of its Director Emeritus. The Ed Lentz Prize is a \$500 award given annually to an individual who has created a work (writing, presentation, film, other) within the past three years that **documents, evokes, interprets, analyzes or captures the importance of place and its preservation.**

CRITERIA:

- Work must provide a better understanding of history, architecture, and/or importance of historic preservation and design excellence of the built environment in Central Ohio
- Work must have been created within the past three years

ENTRIES:

- Entries may be emailed, postmarked or hand delivered
- Applicants must submit this application and four copies of the entry, accompanied by a 300-word maximum statement describing how the work fulfills the goals of the prize
- Entries must be received by 5 p.m., Jan. 15, 2021 and will not be returned

JUDGING:

A panel of three judges will review all entries meeting the application criteria and format requirements and will select the work of the individual that they consider best in overall quality. Judges reserve the right not to award the prize, if in their opinion no submission merits an award.
