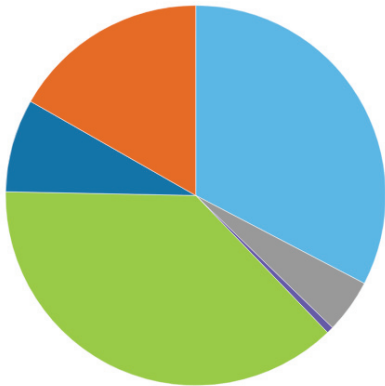

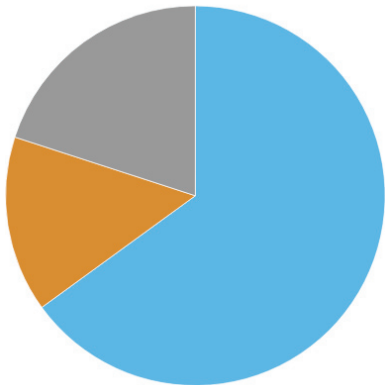

Columbus Landmarks established this fund to gain control of endangered properties through donation, real estate options, or short-term ownership, and take vigorous steps in their defense. The Fund was seeded with a \$200,000 bequest received in 2019 from the Albert W. and Bonnie J. Van Fossen Fund at The Columbus Foundation.



Columbus Landmarks established this fund to provide low-interest home improvement loans in neighborhoods that have experienced disinvestment and areas that have yet to benefit from the economic advantages of historic preservation. The Home Preservation Loan Fund has been seeded through careful stewardship of *\$100,000 received from an unrestricted bequest from Dixie Sayre Miller's estate in 2010.
